A dinner will be provided on Saturday night. The State Staff will cook and provide the main dish. Each chapter was asked to bring: **(2) salads and (2) desserts** for 20 people, 6 or more rigs. If you have less than 6 rigs (1) salad and (1) dessert for 20 people would be your assignment.

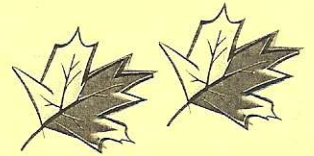
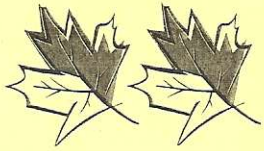
